## Maths

We have been looking at place value in Maths this week finishing with sequences. Choose a challenge from the sheet and see if you can find the pattern or rule. This week you also have a Platinum challenge which is there if you wish to stretch yourselves. You should do this in your Maths homework book and remember to write the date and which challenge you have chosen at the top of the page. If you are not sure which to choose, start with silver and then try one of the others.

## Literacy

We have been learning about narrative structure in Literacy by reading *The Fib* and looking at the author's style. We have also looked at how to write a reading journal. For homework, can you write a short reading journal entry for a book that you have enjoyed reading? Remember to include the following:

- Name of the book and author
- Brief outline of what has happened so far (5Ws)
- Whether you enjoyed the book

You could also include information about your favourite part or character, a prediction of the ending if you are still reading the book, questions you might like to ask the author or an alternative ending. You could also include references to your own experiences. This should be done in your literacy homework book.
